

Italian Wines in the World: Cantina Vivaldis's Stif 2059 Pinot Nero 2017

Pinot Noir is for many aficionados synonymous with classy wine. Rather bizarre to cultivate, not at all flexible in the vineyard and in the cellar, it needs unique soil and climatic conditions to be able to express itself according to criteria of elegance and finesse. During the winemaking process, it requires attention, forcing winemakers and cellarmen to have to use all their skill. From Burgundy, its place of origin, to Italy where in some specific areas it finds that happy nobility, showing its sublime distinctive profile. As in the Trentino area, at the foot of Monte Stivo, in the territory of Sasso and Monte Ghello, where Cantina Vivallis has been able to enhance its features by bringing out fruit and freshness. From their most suitable area at 500 meters above sea level, from selected vineyards and low yields, the “Stif 2059” project, awarded by The WineHunter, creator of the Merano Wine Festival 2020, comes to life. A few days of cold maceration at 10 ° C and vinification separated from some selections, they bring elegant pale ruby □□red nuances to the glass. The nose opens to small red fruits, indulges in a distinct and multidisciplinary sip. The decisive attack tells of a mineral tension and a consistency that does not offer roughness or rigidity, but which focuses on a round tannin, on a gustatory performance of a great terroir wine.

To be tasted in large glasses that highlight the spicy nuances, served at a temperature of 16 degrees, paired with a Chateaubriand Fillet.

Company Profile

The brand Vivallis was born in 2004 from the centuries-old heritage of Società Agricoltori Vallagarina – Vallis Agri Scarl. “VI” as vinegrowers (viticoltori), vine (vite), wine (vino) and life (vita), “VALLIS” to remark the strong connection with the Latin origins and with the well-established enological culture of the valley. The brand mirrors the historical and passionate link to the work in the

vineyard and in the cellar as coherent expression of its territory. Today Vivallis conveys the strength of its roots (dating back to 1908) by harvesting and vinifying grapes from over 900 hectares of vineyards which are located in traditional areas and are wisely cultivated by over 700 farmers under the supervision of an expert team of agronomists and winemakers. The production goal is ambitious: bringing culture, history and passion for the past into our wines and offering more modern products through a controlled use of innovative technology in order to continue to be a true and dynamic expression of Vallagarina.
