Nothing happens by chance. Vigna Dogarina, a company of the Vi.V.O. Cantine, faces the world of winelovers in constant progression, both for its wine making direction, thanks to a precise focus of its wines, and for its connection to the territory: Caranto – alluvial sediment area rich in calcium and magnesium -, are characteristic soils of the Venetian Alps and of that strip of land that in the provinces of Venice and Treviso takes the name of DOC Venezia.

This Merlot has form and substance; composite nose, varied and consistent on the palate. Merlot is a vine that embraces different places and terroirs, it is a great classic, fully corresponding to the place of origin although its cosmopolitan entirety.

It is full of varietal identity, with a complex personality that captures the thousand nuances of its essence: balsamic breath and beautiful tension, breadth and depth, persistence and length. This wine has got a brilliant ruby –red colour, it is pure energy, a long-limbed nectar tempered by the warmth of the red fruit, the crunchiness of the cherry, the more vegetal aromas of the green pepper. Easy-going on the palate, it raises the olfactory harmony and a rather eloquent youth on the palate.

A family portrait label, once again the expression of an increasingly sustainable and technologically advanced winery. I paired it with a course of arrostiticini sticks and grilled vegetables.
