

Mandrarossa's Urra di Mare

A Sicily that is both contemporary and ancient, a sun that in this wine carries the scent of the sea like no other, a long history of viticulture and expertise connecting this international grape variety to the Mediterranean breeze. What Mandrarossa offers to the international markets is a true ode to modernity: a 100% Sauvignon of rare finesse and aromatic harmony.

In the southwest of this splendid island, the territory of Menfi is set like a diamond, a microcosm of culture and flavors. It is here that the Menfi DOC "Urrà di Mare" is born, capturing the very soul of this land. The result of a decades-long journey to create a white wine of character and finesse, its nose reveals alluring mineral notes intertwined with exotic fruit, citrus, and apricot, while a delicate scent of Mediterranean scrub emerges as it breathes in the glass.

The palate is one of complete harmony; a fresh mineral note gives way to white-fleshed fruit, culminating in a persistent, balanced finish. This is a wine to be savored with your eyes closed, almost as if listening to the sea breeze that caressed the grapes, allowing your thoughts to return, even for just a moment, to that land of rare beauty.

Paired with seafood, salmon crêpes, or an exquisite dish of Catalan-style red prawns, it harmonizes with and enhances the food. Its tangible finesse never forgets the sunny character of this island.

Mandrarossa is a brand of 100% Sicilian wines, an authentic expression of the island's biodiversity. It was founded in 1999, from a study lasting over 20 years that led to the identification of the best variety/terroir combination to ensure that each type of grape expresses its potential to its best. All the grapes produced by Mandrarossa generate wines that are an expression of a different Sicily, one that innovates and experiments: an unexpected Sicily.
