

SCAIA's Corvina

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The fascinating story that the Castagnedi brothers, owners of Tenuta Sant'Antonio, tell regarding the birth of this important (and farsighted) winery located in the east of the Verona province, surprises every time with its simplicity and contemporary nature.

The story begins with the land, from that so-called “extended Valpolicella” to the east of Verona: a prestigious territory, cradle of the first Veronese DOC. It is a land endowed with a soul and an indomitable strength of character, yet one that finds its most intriguing aspect in its deeply rooted identity, especially on a viticultural level.

Scaia is one of the Castagnedi Family's brands, born from a bold vision: to create wines that break with tradition, placing pleasure and accessibility at the centre of every glass. The brand's philosophy is rooted in a contemporary

reinterpretation of Veronese winemaking heritage, blending native grapes and international varieties with innovative techniques. Thanks to carefully selected vineyards, distinctive stylistic choices (such as the unmistakable glass stopper), and a strong visual identity, Scaia stands out as a truly unique wine: young, versatile, accessible, and unforgettable. Scaia speaks to a generation of curious and social consumers seeking quality without complications.

We tasted the Corvina from this line, a grape variety that is an integral part of Valpolicella's history. It is a variety that has always been known for belonging to the nobility of Recioto and Amarone, as Corvina itself is the protagonist of the entire famous Veronese denomination.

When Corvina is offered as a single varietal—as in the case of the product we tasted—this extraordinary grape cannot ally itself with its usual companions, such as Molinara, Corvinone, or Rondinella. Instead, it must perform as a soloist, and it possesses all the capabilities to do so very well.

The nose is clean and captivating, with hints of very fine spices and autumnal red fruit that merge with aromas of undergrowth flowers. The palate is precise, extremely precise; there is a beautiful savory-mineral balance accompanying a long finish, thanks to silky tannins that make the whole harmonious and soft.

Here, pairing options multiply thanks to the excellent contemporary style this wine represents in Italian cuisine.
