Anna Spinato was founded in 1952 by the intuition of Pietro Spinato, the father of the current owner. Following on

tradition and passion, in 2002 it started opening up to the international market and nowadays the company exports more than 95% of the bottles it produces. In 2012 the company obtain the organic production certification.

### **PROSECCO ORGANIC BRUT**

In this wine everything recalls the image of a joyful and modern Prosecco that does not betray its origins but wants to conquer those who are looking for immediate pleasantness and spontaneity, but also clarity and the substance of real fruit. Its creamy foam is persistent and fine, filling the glass. It immediately brings to mind the idea of parties and invites you to raise your glass in company. The involving aromatic profile expresses fruity and sweet hints that balance the memories of grapefruit and yeast. And then, great news, the aroma is sweeter than the flavour, demonstrating itself as being so interesting and personal as to deserve being appreciated alone, as an aperitif, with an olive or two and toasted and salted nuts.
