We had a perfect demonstration of the rosé soul by tasting Hedòs, the Cerasuolo d'Abruzzo 2019 by Cantina Tollo that fully satisfied us and therefore we were not surprised that it is one of the most awarded rosés by the main international wine competitions.

With this rosé Cantina Tollo, one of the most dynamic and innovative cooperatives in our country, confirms its constant qualitative evolution.

The color is already what you would always like to find in a rosé, with that bright pink with purple hues. On the nose a decidedly ample aromatic bouquet, with typical sensations of red fruit starting from raspberry and cherry, but also pomegranate, as well as more delicate floral hints of carnation and geranium. In the mouth, great intensity, fragrance and that acid tension that makes it very interesting also for some combinations with fatty meats or fish.

We married it with an excellent aperitif based on cured meats and cheeses and it was a perfect start.
