

Italian wines in the world: Cristo di Campobello's C'D'C' Cristo di Campobello Rosato di Nero d'Avola

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Baglio del Cristo di Campobello belongs to a territory that I would dare to define mystical and that in every expression accompanies you in any direction: taste, harmony, precision, identity, craftsmanship, emotional richness. This is winery with a solid past, a landmark of Sicily, revealed between enchantment and nature. A reality that boasts thirtyfive hectares of rows located in the heart of Agrigento, in a cross-section of chalky-calcareous soils, a material enhanced by precise and traditional vinifications and international varieties that are typical of the territory. Berries and fleshy fruits with an elegant soul, interpreted by men of tenacity and passion who daily grasp the opportunity for harvests that transform the glasses into excellence from a

generous material. Here nature is an order of essence and temperament, landscape and generating power. A place with a mythological fabric that offers a resolved and exemplary viticulture.

C'D'C ', the pink soul of Nero d'Avola, has depth aromas, a compact and linear palate, a fluctuating balance between freshness and fruit, in a decidedly gourmand acid-tannic ensemble.

Company Profile

Baglio del Cristo in Campobello, founded in 2000, is located in Campobello di Licata, in a hilly position between 230 and 270 meters above sea level and 8,000 meters from the coast. Thirtyfive hectares of vineyard on the fifty owned by the company, a single organism of ten micro-areas. Deep soil, mixed chalky and calcareous, of hilly terrain, with a density of 5,000 plants per hectare, all hand-harvested in small boxes, as required tradition.
