Sometimes wine is the liquid manifestation of silence, once wrote Sepulveda, and in the silence of an autumn morning, in the courtyard of Varramista, a place that hosted great writers, poets and personalities from the world of culture and international entrepreneurship, we fully appreciate the importance of this silence, a harmony interrupted only by the scent of the grape harvest.

The red Varramista, a wine dedicated to the estate, is expressed with the same sobriety as those who have made this area shine, and who wanted to represent it with a vine that binds history and traditions of cultures like few others, the Syrah.

The 100% Syrah is the wine obtained from aging in small wood and from vineyards that have been present in this area of Tuscany for many years. The label represents the beautiful villa, the fulcrum of the reception area, and by uncorking the bottle in front of the beautiful garden, we also admire the typical color of Syrah, a black that recalls the night, with brilliant ruby shades, tilting the glass to the light. The sense of smell is an immersion in the noblest spices, with notes that come from rhubarb and cranberry juice, while in the mouth its rustic and genuine part emerges, that a well balanced tannin accompanies us in softness, the finish is rich and very long, with balsamic notes of eucalyptus and cocoa. The exquisite simplicity is the truth of this wine, which we define as transversal in the combinations that can go from a baked pasta to a grill of assorted meats, and you will appreciate it even more for its elegant discretion, which is the true characteristic of Varramista.

Company Profile

Fattoria Varramista S.p.A. is a Tuscan firm, with a past of noble Florentines families and modern entrepreneurs, that manufactures red wines in the wonderful Terre di Pisa land. In the '90s Giovanni Alberto Agnelli, who inherited the magnificent estate from his grandfather Enrico Piaggio, the inventor of Vespa scooter, implemented the re-conversion of the vineyards and production system under the guidance of Federico Staderini, the oenologist who carries on Dr. Agnelli's project to date. The Sangiovese, the typical Tuscan variety, was joined by some international varieties, like Syrah that was elected as the main grapevine and essential ingredient of Varramista, our cru. During the time we added three other wines, Frasca, Sterpato and Chianti Monsonaccio. Today we are focused on letting wine lovers and professionals visiting us and discovering how much attention and care we devote to our products.
