“Raboso Piave” is a very old natural red grape variety that has found its ideal habitat on the banks of the River Piave, and we greatly appreciated the idea of vinifying it in pink, together with Pinot Nero, to create a wine with its roots deep in territorial history but which is also suitable for modern consumer stylists and international markets. The wine conquers you while still in the glass, with its magnificently bright deep pink colour, the prelude of vivid aromas of strawberry caramel. A sip takes you to a dimension of pure and ancestral pleasure where the spicy hints of vanilla

play with caramel and candyfloss, leaving you the pleasure of discovering a final rich vein that preserves a harmony of superior level.
